I coordinated the editing and production of the title *Ethiopia*, *Eritrea & Djibouti 1*, which was a wholly original work written by Frances Linzee Gordon and published by Lonely Planet publications in 2000.

Frances has written what Lonely Planet is certain will become the 'blue bible' to the Horn of Africa. Frances was a pleasure to work with: witty and responsive, her research was impeccable, her desire to cooperate in the production of her book was second-to-none.
